Travel can be difficult for mothers who are breastfeeding. John Glenn Columbus International Airport and Rickenbacker airport are moving to accommodate them by installing modular lactation rooms by early spring.

The units will feature "door locks, soft lighting, a chair and ottoman, an adjustable side table and power outlets," according to an emailed newsletter from the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. They will be located in each concourse and on the baggage claim level at John Glenn, and in the charter terminal at Rickenbacker.
