Delta Expands Port Columbus Service Again *Additional flights to Boston and Raleigh-Durham, Cancun service initiated*

COLUMBUS – Port Columbus International Airport passengers heading to Raleigh-Durham and Boston on Delta Air Lines have more nonstop options from which to choose. Effective today, Delta is increasing service to Raleigh-Durham from one to two daily flights and on April 2 the airline will expand its daily Boston frequency from three to four flights.

Delta previously announced the addition of nonstop service from Columbus to Cancun, which began Feb. 19. Columbus is among four U.S. cities that Delta selected to initiate the seasonal service that operates on Saturdays from Port Columbus.

With these air service additions Delta provides 39 daily departures from Port Columbus to 11 airports, representing more daily departures and destinations than any other airline at the airport. Delta carries 23 percent of all Port Columbus passengers, second only to Southwest Airlines.

“Columbus is a very important market in Delta’s global network,” said Don Bornhorst, Senior Vice President of Delta Air Lines. “Travelers have responded quite favorably to the additional service that Delta introduced in recent months. We will continue focusing on Columbus as we grow and expand our airline.”

Beginning mid-year 2010 through today, Delta added or announced new or expanded service from Port Columbus to Atlanta, Boston, Cancun, Detroit, Los Angeles, New York-La Guardia, Raleigh-Durham and Washington National. Delta also serves Memphis, Minneapolis-St. Paul and New York-JFK from Port Columbus.

“Delta has invested significantly in Columbus and we truly appreciate it,” said David Whitaker, Vice President of Business Development for the Columbus Regional Airport Authority which operates Port Columbus. “The flights Delta already provides, along with the planned additional service, gives our business and leisure travelers more options with high quality service.”

In addition to Delta, Port Columbus carriers include Air Canada Jazz, AirTran, American, Continental, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, United and US Airways. The airport currently provides 148 daily departures to 34 airports.
