### **Mixed Media Artwork by Tyler Bohm On Display in New Port Columbus Exhibit**

COLUMBUS – Mixed media artwork by Columbus artist Tyler Bohm is now on display in the Port Columbus Gateway to The Arts, an exhibit space located on the ticketing level in the hallway behind MoJoe Lounge.

Port Columbus Gateway to The Arts is a collaboration between the Columbus Regional Airport Authority and the Ohio Art League, which is a nonprofit visual arts organization that coordinates the rotating exhibits on a quarterly basis.

“An immense and complicated web of relationships links us to technologies of every imaginable sort,” explained Bohm. “As one consequence of this interdependency, our technologies increasingly take on human attributes like intelligence and autonomy. This uncanny state of affairs, both intriguing and alienating, is the backdrop for the visual ideas I have been exploring.”

Bohm has developed a unique process in creating his artwork. He starts the piece using Computer-Aided Design (CAD) then sends the artwork to a laser cutter to get the CAD file cut out of Plexiglas. Next, Bohm paints the resulting components on the reverse side and reassembles the artwork, mounting together several layers of Plexiglas.

“This process is, like the themes explored in my work, a symptom of the increasingly strange correspondence between human and technological activity,” said Bohm. Visit [www.tylerbohm.com](http://www.tylerbohm.com) to learn more about Bohm and his work.

Bohm received a Bachelor of Arts from Kenyon College and a Master of Philosophy from Wadham College at Oxford University in the United Kingdom. He spent time in Russia, becoming interested in Russian art and architecture. He moved from small-scale pen and ink drawings to larger-scale mixed media works that reflect his interest in language and industrial design. He has exhibited his work multiple places around Columbus including the McConnell Arts Center of Worthington, the Acme Art Company, ROY G BIV Gallery and the Columbus Museum of Art. He has also exhibited his artwork at the Indianapolis Art Center, Visual Arts Center of New Jersey, Contemporary Art Institute of Detroit, South Shore Art Center in Cohasset, MA and in Canada at Cube Gallery in Ontario.
