## **TSA Pre✓ temporary application center coming to John Glenn International**

COLUMBUS – Travelers interested in saving time in security checkpoint lines can enroll in the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) Pre✓ expedited-screening program at John Glenn Columbus International Airport (CMH) Nov. 7-18, 2016. An application center, located on the baggage claim level across from carousel 6, will be open Monday-Wednesday from 10 a.m.-7 p.m. and Thursday-Friday from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. during this two-week period.

With TSA Pre✓, travelers don't need to remove shoes, laptops, 3-1-1 liquids, belts or light jackets and can enter the checkpoint through a designated TSA Pre✓ lane. TSA Pre✓ lanes have been at CMH since January 2014 and the program continues to gain popularity in the Columbus Region.

"As passenger traffic continues to grow at John Glenn International, we're thrilled to partner with our TSA partners to offer an enrollment center at the airport, in addition to the two local off-airport enrollment centers open year-round," said Elaine Roberts, President & CEO of the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. "The TSA Pre✓ program is a benefit to frequent air travelers in Central Ohio and I encourage them to consider applying."

The membership costs \$85 and is valid for five years. Applicants are strongly encouraged to [pre-enroll online](#) and select an appointment time. Walk-ins will be accepted if time permits. For this enrollment event, applicants will receive complimentary parking in any of the airport's parking lots (valet parking excluded). A parking voucher will be provided upon arrival to the appointment.

At the appointment, applicants will undergo a background check which consists of providing fingerprints and proof of citizenship or legal residency. Once approved, members will receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN) online in about a week that can be used when booking flights. IdentityGO Centers by MorphoTrust, a leader in identity-related services throughout the United States, is the service provider of the enrollment center for TSA Pre✓.

### **John Glenn Columbus International Airport**

Centrally located in Ohio, John Glenn International is one of three airports operated by the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. Opened in 1929, the airport offers nearly 150 daily departures to 33 destinations from Columbus, the 15th largest U.S. city.
