TSA PreCheck temporary application center coming to John Glenn International

COLUMBUS – Travelers interested in saving time at security checkpoint lines can enroll in the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) PreCheck expedited-screening program at John Glenn Columbus International Airport (CMH) Feb. 27-March 10. An application center, located on the baggage claim level across from carousel 6, will be open Monday-Wednesday from 10 a.m.-7 p.m. and Thursday-Friday from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. during this two-week period.

With TSA PreCheck, travelers don't need to remove shoes, laptops, 3-1-1 liquids, belts or light jackets and can enter the checkpoint through a designated TSA PreCheck lane. The TSA PreCheck program has been at CMH since January 2014 and continues to gain popularity in the Columbus Region.

"We had a very successful temporary enrollment center at the airport in November and we're thrilled to partner with our TSA partners again," said Elaine Roberts, President & CEO of the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. "As our passenger traffic continues to increase year over year, programs such as TSA PreCheck are very valuable to frequent travelers."

The membership costs \$85 and is valid for five years. Applicants are strongly encouraged to [pre-enroll online](#) and select an appointment time. Walk-ins will be accepted if time permits. For this enrollment event, applicants will receive complimentary parking in any of the airport's parking lots (valet parking excluded). A parking voucher will be provided upon arrival to the appointment.

At the appointment, applicants will undergo a background check which consists of providing fingerprints and proof of citizenship or legal residency. Once approved, members will receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN) online in about a week that can be used when booking flights. IdentityGO® Centers by MorphoTrust, a leader in identity-related services throughout the United States, is the service provider of the enrollment center for TSA PreCheck.

John Glenn Columbus International Airport

Centrally located in Ohio, John Glenn International is one of three airports operated by the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. Opened in 1929, the airport offers up to 150 daily departures to 33 destinations from Columbus, the 15th largest U.S. city. More than 7.3 million passengers traveled through the airport in 2016.
