## **John Glenn Columbus International Airport provides private nursing rooms for traveling mothers**

*Private room also now available at Rickenbacker Charter Terminal*

COLUMBUS – Parents traveling through John Glenn Columbus International Airport are enjoying new family-focused amenities with the installation of several nursing rooms throughout the terminal, providing a quieter and more private location for mothers to feed their children.

“We understand that traveling with children can be fun and exciting, but it also presents unique challenges for parents and we want to make the experience as positive as it can be,” said Elaine Roberts, President & CEO of the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. “We hope the addition of these comfortable spaces for nursing mothers and their children will make their journey through our airports even easier and more pleasant.”

The private nursing rooms are only the most recent addition to the many other amenities geared toward enhancing the customer experience in Columbus airports. John Glenn International also provides free children’s activity books and crayons, family restrooms, the availability of skycap services, and even individualized pre-travel tours for autistic children and their families.

A total of four nursing rooms have been installed at John Glenn International. There is one in each concourse and one in baggage claim. A private nursing room has also been installed at the Rickenbacker Charter Terminal. The nursing stations are available for women and their children who prefer a quieter, more private area for breastfeeding.
