TSA PreCheck temporary application center returning to John Glenn International

COLUMBUS – Travelers interested in saving time at security checkpoint lines can enroll in the Transportation Security Administration’s (TSA) PreCheck expedited-screening program at John Glenn Columbus International Airport (CMH) Nov. 6-17. An application center, located on the baggage claim level across from carousel 6, will be open during this two-week period on Monday-Thursday between 9 a.m.-1 p.m. and 2 p.m.-6 p.m., as well Friday from 8.a.m.- Noon and 1 p.m.-5 p.m.

With TSA PreCheck, travelers don’t need to remove shoes, laptops, 3-1-1 liquids, belts or light jackets and can enter the checkpoint through a designated TSA PreCheck lane. The TSA PreCheck program has been at CMH since January 2014 and continues to gain popularity in the Columbus Region.

“We’re honored to partner with our TSA partners to host another temporary TSA PreCheck enrollment center at John Glenn International,” said Elaine Roberts, President & CEO of the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. “This program provides convenient benefits to frequent air travelers and we’ve heard positive feedback from those who are enrolled.”

The membership costs \$85 and is valid for five years. Applicants are strongly encouraged to [pre-enroll online](#) and select an appointment time. Walk-ins will be accepted if time permits. For this enrollment event, applicants will receive complimentary parking in any of the airport’s parking lots (valet parking excluded). A parking voucher will be provided upon arrival to appointment.

At the appointment, applicants will undergo a background check which consists of providing fingerprints and proof of citizenship or legal residency. Once approved, members will receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN) online in about a week that can be used when booking flights. IdentityGO® Centers by MorphoTrust, a leader in identity-related services throughout the United States, is the service provider of the enrollment center for TSA PreCheck.

John Glenn Columbus International Airport

Centrally located in Ohio, John Glenn International is one of three airports operated by the Columbus Regional Airport Authority. Opened in 1929, the airport offers up to 150 daily departures to 36 destinations from Columbus, the 14th largest U.S. city. More than 7 million passengers traveled through the airport in 2016.
