



Contract Compliance Management System Announcement

Columbus Regional Airport Authority is pleased to announce its new Contract Compliance Monitoring System, B2GNow. **The web-based software system is accessible to all prime and related sub-firms of various disciplines, and includes the following key features:**

- Enhanced online directory with key-word search capabilities
- Communication with contractors via email, regarding compliance issues
- Submission of payment to subcontractors online, and automated tracking of their progress (or lack thereof) towards meeting DBE/DBP Goals
- DBE and DBP verification of payment notices
- Submission of any required compliance documents addressed within the contract agreements.

Our "go live" date is May 1, 2019 after which all the above functions are being processed online through our system. The system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and permits contractors to remain in compliance with the reporting requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 and CRAA.

There is no cost to contractors for this system. Initially you are the point of contact and have a user account. You can add as many employees as necessary that require access to the system to report and view contract compliance data (please do not share accounts between people).

Please assist us with our system roll-out by logging into your account or creating a new account, updating your password if appropriate and reviewing the contact information for your business. You will be able to view and review your contracts for accuracy and completeness.
